

One tenured Professorship in Econometrics (W3)

The Department of Economics at the University of Bonn is seeking to fill one tenured professorship (full professor, W3) in the field of Econometrics beginning in the summer semester 2018. Particularly important is the candidate's ability to conduct top-level research in econometrics, as evidenced by publications in highly ranked international journals. The teaching load generally corresponds to two courses per semester. All teaching at the graduate level is conducted in English.

Candidates have to comply with the general prerequisites according to § 36 Higher Act of Education of North Rhine-Westphalia (Hochschulgesetz des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen).

The University of Bonn promotes the diversity of its members. It is certified as a family-oriented university and has a dual career program. Its aim is to increase the proportion of women in scientific staff and to promote their careers in particular. It therefore urges qualified women to apply.
