The position will be based at the MacroFinance and MacroHistory Lab at the Institute for Macroeconomics and Econometrics under the direction of Prof. Moritz Schularick. Our research group analyzes the impact of financial liberalization on credit supply and house prices in the post-World War II period across OECD countries. The research assistant will be involved in the construction of a comprehensive account of the timing and content of liberalization policies.

Applicants should be in their Master's degree in economics or history and have shown above-average performance in their studies. They should be highly motivated to examine historical documents of country authorities and to work with quantitative data in a team environment. Good communication and writing skills in English are required. Skills in an additional language as well as basic knowledge of Stata and/or LaTeX are an advantage.
