- Fachschaftsrat (FSR) student council
  - All econ students are part of it you are invited to come to our meetings!
  - Board, Freshmen-Unit, Party-Unit, IT & Communication-Unit, Event-Unit,
    Organisation-Unit, Master & International-Unit
  - Every unit has a speaker
- Fachschaftsvertretung (FSV) student council representation
  - Elected by all econ students
  - Highest authority of the student representatives
  - Board (3 members) and 12 further members
