

User Guide: Allocation Procedure for Research Modules

This guide describes the allocation procedure ("Belegverfahren") for Research Modules in the Master's program in Economics.

1. Prerequisites

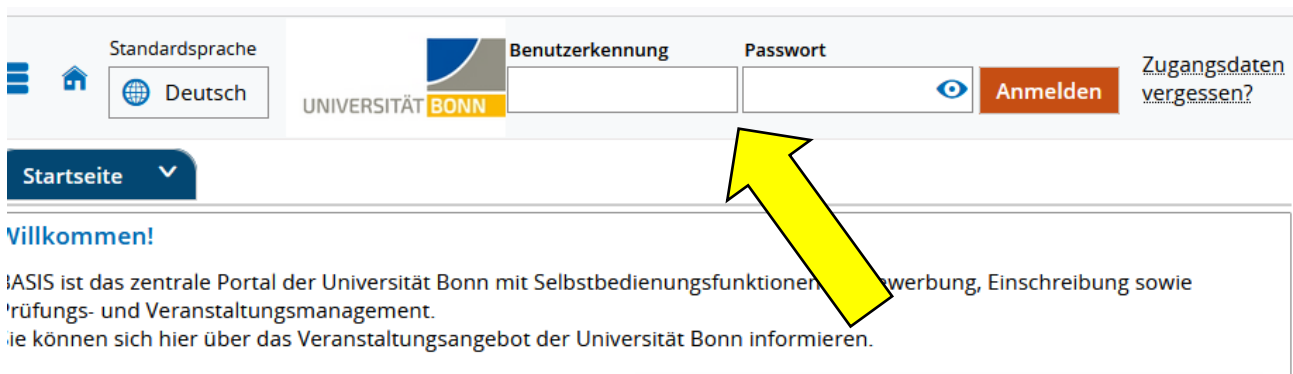
Before you start, please ensure that:

- You are enrolled in the Master's program in Economics for the relevant semester (winter term).
- You have access to the university's campus management system (login credentials required).
- You are aware of the specific Research Module requirements stated in the examination regulations.

2. Registration Process

Step 1: Access the System

1. Open the university's campus management system in your browser

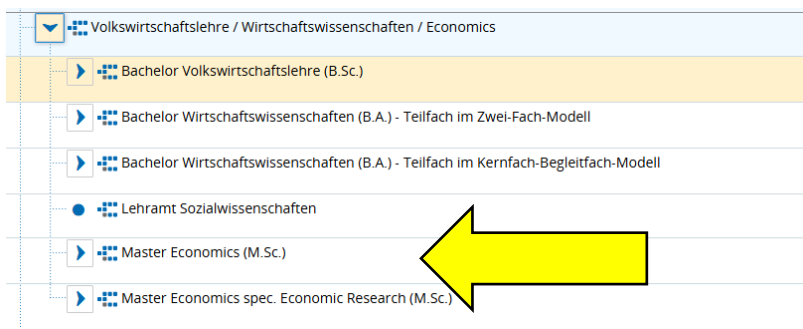

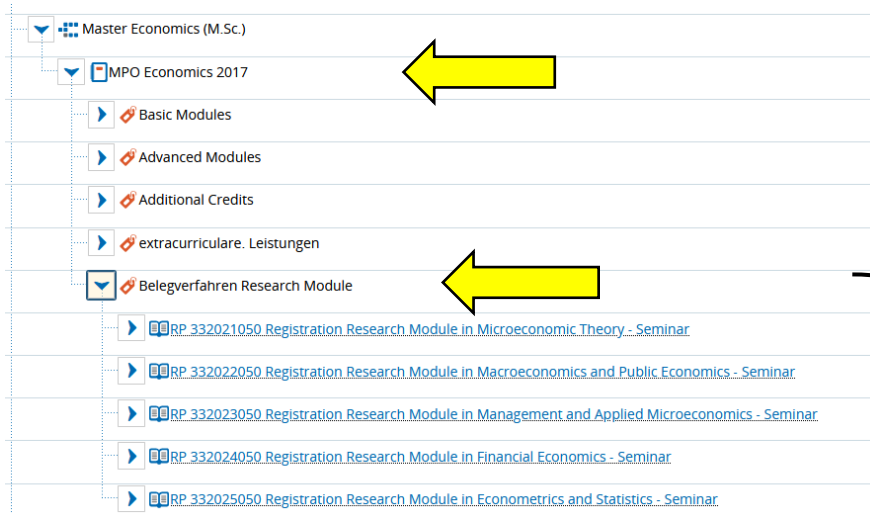

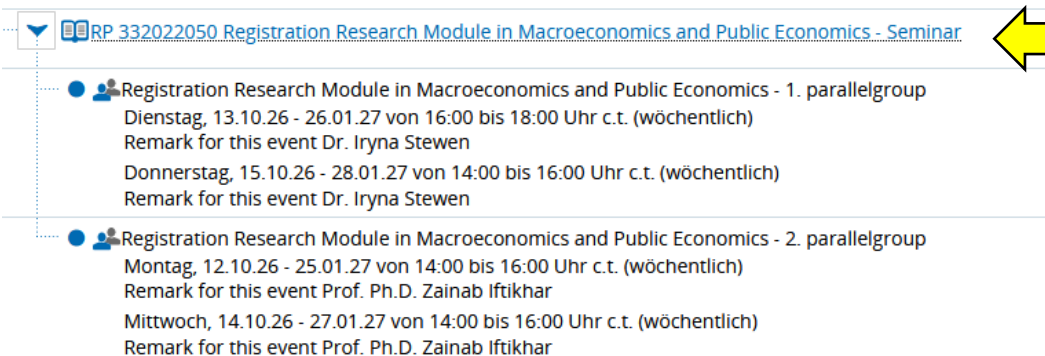

Step 3: Define your priorities

1. You now need to define and submit your priorities.
2. When assigning priorities, you must distinguish between Seminar and the Parallel group.

Seminar:	Parallel group:
• Priority 1 = Preferred • Priority 2 = 1. Alternative • Priority 3 = 2. Alternative	• Prio 1 = Priority 1 • Prio 2 = Priority 2

Priorities are assigned by first selecting the Seminar, then ranking Parallel groups, if more than one is available.

If one Research Module has two parallel groups, you can prioritize one group and not prioritize the other group.

If you also want to prioritize the second parallel group then your priorities must be in sequence. You cannot for example choose to prioritize one parallel group (1) then choose a different seminar (2) and then go back and choose the second parallel group (3). That option is not available due to technical reasons.

Example:

1. Imagine you want to prioritize as follows:

	Study field
Prio 1:	Registration Research Module in Management and Applied Microeconomics, parallel group 2
Prio 2	Registration Research Module in Microeconomic Theory
Prio 3	Registration Research Module in Econometrics and Statistics

2. Choose the following settings for the Research Module Management and Applied Microeconomics.

- Registration Research Module in Management and Applied Microeconomics => **“preferred”**
 - Parallel group 2: „**priority 1**“
 - Parallel group 1: do not assign a priority

3. Choose the following settings for the Research Module in Microeconomic Theory.

- Registration Research Module in Microeconomic Theory => **“1. Alternative”**

4. Choose the following settings for the Research Module in Econometrics and Statistics.

- Registration Research Module in Econometrics and Statistics => **“2. Alternative”**
