The GETTSIM team invites you to participate in the 2026 GETTSIM Workshop, taking place on September 3–4, 2026, at the Digital Hub Bonn – City Hub.

GETTSIM, the *German Taxes and Transfers Simulator* (<https://gettsim.readthedocs.io/en/stable/>), is an open-source Python package that provides a detailed and transparent representation of the German tax and transfer system. It is designed for a wide range of research and microsimulation applications.

- Research projects and applications using tax and transfer simulations
- Recent GETTSIM developments, including the 1.0 release and features added since then
- Tools and workflows in the GETTSIM ecosystem, including the SOEP preparation pipeline and working with personas
- Discussion of tax-benefit modeling practice and priorities for future GETTSIM development
